Future Stars is a developmental Netball programme for girls who are keen to learn about Netball and have the opportuity to meet a London Pulse professional athlete.

Our Programme Aim

Our mission is to:

- 2. To create a safe, fun learning environment.
- 3. To get active, whilst learning new skills.
- 4. To start working with younger athletes preparing them to join the London Pulse Pathway!

What to expect

Sessions are available on Friday or Sunday evenings from January to the end of March – term time from 17:00 – 18:30.

Sessions focus on developing fundamental movement skills including running, jumping, throwing and catching, as well as developing balance, agility and co-ordination, and begin to apply these in a range of activities.

Positive reinforcement focus

Confidence is a great attribute to develop. It helps children believe in themselves, helps them to talk to others at school and in social situations and gives them the courage to try new and challenging things.

Our focus is creating a fun and inclusive environment for all the girls. A high-fives and words of encouragement from the other children will give them a real confidence boost.







How will the sessions work?

Each session starts off with a team talk, introducing any children who are new to group and explaining what the session will involve.

Will get straight into an active warm up and then head into group activity.

Netball skills are incorporated into themed games and activities as well as the fundamentals such as:

- Footwork, passing and catching
- Variety of movement skills
- Basics of attack and defence principles
